

## **CES TESTING FOR FIREFIGHTER/EMT-III/ACLS AND FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC**

CES will conduct testing for Firefighter/EMT-III and Firefighter/Paramedic on Saturday, July 10th and Sunday, July 11th.

We will be hiring two personnel in July 2010. We will also establish an eligibility list for future vacancies.

Firefighter/EMT-III Minimum Qualifications: High school diploma, or GED; one year of emergency medical and/or structural firefighting experience either as a paid employee or as an on-call employee; and have current Firefighter I and Emergency Medical Technician II certifications by the State of Alaska. Shall obtain Firefighter II and EMT-III/ACLS certification during the probationary period. This position requires a valid Alaska driver's license that must be maintained at all times. Must reside within 15 minutes response time of a department station. Experience as an on-call employee with Central Emergency Services, EMS certification as a paramedic, an AA degree in Fire Science/Paramedicine, or a BS degree in Fire Administration/Business Administration preferred. Physical Ability Testing will be required if you have not successfully passed the CES PAT in the past 12 months. Must become Engineer within 24 months.

Firefighter/Paramedic Minimum Qualifications: High school diploma or GED; one year of emergency medical and/or structural firefighting experience; Firefighter I and Emergency Medical Technician/Paramedic by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians certifications, and licensed by the Alaska State Medical Board as a Mobile Intensive Care Paramedic. Shall obtain Firefighter II certification during the probationary period; and possess a valid Alaska driver's license. Must reside within 15 minutes response time of a department station. Physical Ability Testing will be required if you have not successfully passed the CES PAT in the past 12 months. Must become Engineer within 24 months.
