Keynote Speaker

Debra J. Jarvis is a retired fire chief with more than 30 years cumulative public safety experience.

She served eight years as a fire chief in the Chicago suburbs with the previous 17 years in Indianapolis area suburban fire departments. For the last six years she has provided consulting and training services for public safety and not-for-profit organizations throughout the United States in organizational development, leadership, management, strategic planning, and diversity and inclusion. Chief Jarvis also teaches Executive Fire Officer courses on campus for the National Fire Academy in Maryland, and has participated in a number of initiatives regarding firefighter safety and building bridges within the fire department, as well as between community groups and their fire departments. She also served seven years on the Human Relations Committee for the International Association of Fire Chiefs and volunteers as a race relations study circle facilitator in Indianapolis.

Chief Jarvis is a graduate of the National Fire Academy Executive Fire Officer Program and a Harvard fellow from the Senior Executives in State and Local Government Program at the John F. Kennedy School of Government. Her education includes a master's degree in leadership studies, a bachelor's degree in management, and an associate's degree in fire science.
